



Product Overview

Archipelago's electronic fishing log on a tablet app called FishVue FLOAT has been used in the Canadian Pacific Halibut, Sablefish, Lingcod, and Rockfish fisheries since 2017 and will now be available for all fisheries globally. FishVue FLOAT can be customized to suit the needs of any skipper or observer logbook. When E-LOGS are used, automated reports can be viewed in real-time while at sea. For example, the app provides a warning of any likely mistakes in the log, catch summaries can be viewed and emailed to buyers or quota managers, and fishing activity can be viewed on a map and filtered by month and species to easily see what areas have been the most successful over time. FishVue FLOAT also holds reference documents such as local species identification, and documents such as quota status reports can be received through the app whenever the tablet is connected to the internet. Using E-LOGS takes advantage of technologies to record some information with just one tap, making filling out the logs much faster, easier, and more accurate.

Reference materials:

Archipelago's custom electronic fishing log application, FishVue FLOAT, allows vessel operators to electronically enter and submit their fishing log information. The application gives access to audits and species identification materials and retains log data from previous trips for future reference. FishVue FLOAT is designed for the Android tablet platform.

Agreement and Enrollment Form

In order to improve the delivery of the GHLCMP and increase client satisfaction, an electronic application for harvesters to enter fisher logbook data electronically has been developed by Archipelago - FLOAT. FLOAT was designed for the Android platform and requires the following specifications for the tablet device it will be used on:

- Android 5.0 or higher (we recommend Android 8.0 or higher for new tablet purchases);
- GPS enabled; and
- Designed for a 9 inch screen or larger. Tablets with smaller screen may be more difficult to read and use with the app.

Skippers interested in using the electronic logbook will be responsible for purchasing and maintaining their own tablet. Archipelago has done all the development and testing on Samsung Tab A models or newer. Protective cases are recommended. Archipelago uses Gumdrops cases for all of their DMP tablets. Archipelago will provide the application to skippers to download via the email provided below. Members of Archipelago's GHLCMP management team will provide application support to skippers and each user will be provided with a detailed user guide.
