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Overview

KEY FACTS TO KNOW

- **Extime Duty Free Paris** runs duty free across the airport — a joint venture between Groupe ADP (51%) and Lagardère Travel Retail (49%) that rebranded the airport's earlier retail operation.
- As gateway to a fashion capital, CDG leans hard into **couture and haute-luxury flagship boutiques** alongside an extensive wine, spirits and French gastronomy selection.
- Arguably carries the **deepest true luxury lineup** of any European airport.

T1 Terminal 1

International carriers, largely outside the SkyTeam network

KEY FEATURES

- Reopened in 2023 as Extime's "**flagship boutique terminal**" following a full redesign of the terminal's circular departure hall.
- Serves the broad mix of international, largely **non-SkyTeam carriers** that use the terminal.

NOTABLE SHOPS

- **Gucci** and **Bottega Veneta** anchor the terminal's luxury lineup alongside **Chanel**.

2E/2F Terminal 2E / 2F — Air France & SkyTeam Hub

Air France and SkyTeam carriers — CDG's densest cluster of duty free

KEY FEATURES

- This is CDG's **main event for duty free**: the halls of Terminal 2E (Halls K, L and M) and neighboring 2F carry the airport's densest cluster of designer houses.

NOTABLE SHOPS

- **Chanel** and **Dior** cluster around Hall K, with **Hermès** and **Cartier** nearby.
- A **Longchamp** boutique sits in Hall M.
- **Swarovski**, **Tiffany & Co.** and **Cartier** all run outposts spanning both 2E and 2F.

Other Terminals 2A / 2C / 2D / 2G & 3

Standard Extime duty free, without the dedicated flagships of T1 and 2E/2F

KEY FEATURES

- These halls, plus the more low-cost-oriented Terminal 3, carry standard Extime duty free — **perfumes, cosmetics, spirits and confectionery** — without the dedicated couture flagships concentrated in T1 and 2E/2F.

Other Things to Know

Depends on whether your destination is inside or outside the EU

RESTRICTIONS & LIMITS

- **EU destinations**: you are not eligible for duty-free tax exemptions — you can still shop at airport stores, but pay standard French retail prices.
- **Non-EU destinations** (e.g. USA, UK, UAE): you get full duty-free tax exemption, saving roughly **12% to 20% VAT**, upon showing your boarding pass at checkout.
