KEY FACTS TO KNOW

- **The Loop** is the single duty-free brand run by Aer Rianta International (ARI) across both terminals.
- Dublin has an outsized place in duty-free history — credited with opening the **world's first airport duty-free shop**, in 1947.
- Dedicated outlets across the airport support **Irish culture and heritage**, from high-end woolens to artisanal food and chocolates.

SPECIAL OFFERINGS

- **Beauty Price Promise** — guarantees a single discounted price on cosmetics and fragrances, at least **15% lower** than Irish high-street retail, regardless of whether you're flying to an EU or non-EU destination.

T1 Terminal 1

Short-haul & leisure carriers including Ryanair — airside just past security

KEY FEATURES

- T1's **Loop Duty Free** sits airside immediately after security, serving mainly short-haul and leisure carriers including Ryanair.
- Footprint is noticeably smaller than T2's, reflecting T1's faster-turnaround, largely European leisure traffic.

NOTABLE SHOPS

- Brand mix includes **MAC, Jo Malone, Estée Lauder and Tom Ford**.
- A solid **Irish whiskey** selection rounds out the beauty and fragrance offer.

T2 Terminal 2

Aer Lingus's transatlantic hub — home to the larger Loop retail mall

KEY FEATURES

- T2 is home to **Aer Lingus's transatlantic operation** and houses a larger Loop retail mall than T1.

NOTABLE SHOPS

- An expanded fragrance and beauty selection adds **Victoria's Secret and Bobbi Brown** to the T1 lineup.
- **Irish Whiskey Collection** — a shop-in-shop styled more like a fashion boutique than a spirits counter, built around a black Tipperary crystal chandelier.

INTERESTING THINGS TO BUY

- Every bottle in the Irish Whiskey Collection is labeled with **tasting notes and dual duty-free/duty-paid pricing**, making savings easy to compare before buying.

TRAVELER TIPS

- Dublin stocks some of the most **travel-retail-only whiskey bottlings** anywhere, and runs a "Duty Free Whiskey Club" offering insider access to rare bottlings.
