KEY FACTS TO KNOW

- Hong Kong's layout is essentially **one main terminal plus a satellite concourse**.
- Hong Kong maintains its status as a **free port** and premier world-class retail hub.
- Because Hong Kong does not levy **sales tax or VAT**, the prices you see are the prices — there's no need to process tax refunds at customs counters when you depart.

T1-East Terminal 1 — East Hall

HKIA's main luxury shopping hub, just past the main departure checkpoint

KEY FEATURES

- HKIA's main event: the **densest cluster of luxury boutiques** and the largest duty free floorplates at the airport, occupying a broad luxury shopping floor just past the main departure security checkpoint.

NOTABLE SHOPS

- Chanel, Hermès, Dior, Gucci, Cartier** and a run of fine watch and jewellery houses.
- Duty Zero by CDF**'s principal liquor and tobacco stores sit alongside these boutiques.

T1-West Terminal 1 — West Hall

A secondary, more compact zone focused on beauty near Gate 35

KEY FEATURES

- A secondary, more compact shopping zone with a **lighter luxury presence** than East Hall, focused on perfumes, cosmetics and skincare rather than fashion flagships.

NOTABLE SHOPS

- Built around Shilla's **Beauty&You** store near Gate 35.

Midfield Midfield Concourse

Reached by automated people mover — core essentials rather than flagship boutiques

KEY FEATURES

- Reached from the main terminal by **automated people mover**.
- Carries its own duty free offer skewed toward core **liquor, tobacco, confectionery and beauty essentials** for the gates it serves, rather than the flagship boutiques concentrated in East Hall.

Other Things to Know

RESTRICTIONS & LIMITS

- Hong Kong applies **0% duty on all alcohol below 30% ABV**, part of its push to become the wine capital of Asia.

TRAVELER TIPS

- Special **Disney resort merchandise** not found in standard Disney Stores is available at the Magic of Hong Kong Disneyland.
- Additional duty-free luxury shopping is available downtown at the **DFS T Galleria** locations in Causeway Bay and Canton Road.
