KEY FACTS TO KNOW

- **Avolta's Dufry** runs the general Madrid Duty Free stores across the terminals, while **Lagardère's Aelia** operates a standalone luxury zone concentrated in Terminal 1.
- This gives Barajas a dual identity of everyday duty-free convenience alongside what's billed as **the largest dedicated luxury retail space at any Spanish airport**.

T1 Terminal 1

Leisure and lower-cost carriers, home to Aelia's dedicated luxury zone

KEY FEATURES

- Generally used by **leisure and lower-cost carriers**.
- A genuinely high-end retail identity distinct from the airport's larger, more transactional Dufry-run stores elsewhere.

NOTABLE SHOPS

- **The Fashion Gallery** — Aelia's 1,050 sq m luxury zone carrying 21 brands including Bulgari, Salvatore Ferragamo, Montblanc, Omega, Loewe and Burberry.
- **Haute Parfumerie** — Aelia's more intimate fragrance-and-cosmetics space stocking Chanel, Dior, Diptyque and Kérastase.

T4/4S Terminal 4 / 4S

Iberia and oneworld's main long-haul hub, linked by people-mover

KEY FEATURES

- T4 and its satellite T4S, linked by **people-mover**, hold Barajas's largest duty-free footprint.
- **T4S** is the key non-Schengen boarding satellite where travelers access full duty-free allowances.

NOTABLE SHOPS

- **Madrid Duty Free** — run by Dufry, with principal stores on Floor 1 near the J gate pier in T4 and the S gate pier in T4S.

- Beauty, spirits, food and gifts **at scale**.
