LOCATION On a picturesque oceanfront cove adjacent to the village of Grand Case and about a ten minute drive from Marigot, the capital of French St. Martin.

ACCOMMODATIONS Include studios ocean and garden; one bedroom ocean and garden; two bedroom ocean, and deluxe one and two bedroom all with fully equipped kitchens, flat screen cable TV, telephone, bathroom and shower, hair dryer, air conditioning, and a private patio or balcony. The hotel offers a complimentary bottle of French wine in each room.

DINING The Sunset Café, the beachfront restaurant, serves breakfast, lunch, and dinner overlooking the ocean. Grand Case Beach Club is within walking distance to the Village of Grand Case, noted as the gourmet capital of the West Indies.

RECREATION Two white sand beaches and a water sports center for boating, snorkeling and, water based activities. Non-motorized water sports are complimentary. Or, you can relax by the freshwater pool which overlooks the Caribbean.

SIGHTSEEING Explore neighboring islands like British Anguilla, French St. Barths or Dutch Saba by day and enjoy our world-class clubs and casinos by night. Car rentals are available for tours of the French and Dutch sides of our island.

ELECTRICITY The French side of the island operates on 220 volts. Most modern electrical devices are multi voltage; please check your device.

TRANSPORTATION Most International flights arrive at Princess Juliana Airport (SXM) on Dutch St. Maarten, about a half hour's drive from Grand Case Beach Club. French St. Martin has a small airport, approximately five minutes by car from the hotel, which has service to the French islands of St. Barths, Guadalupe, and Martinique with international connections from there.

TRAVEL INFORMATION On arrival, visitors must present a valid passport plus a return ticket home. We recommend that you purchase travel insurance.

CURRENCY The Euro is the official currency used on French St. Martin but U.S. currency is widely accepted.

DRESS Casual attire is acceptable during the day as well as in the evening.
