- Ensuring all equipment throughout the plant is operating safely and at peak performance
- Overhaul and install new equipment.
- Generate and complete work orders in CMMS system.
- Generate parts request to ensure adequate inventory.
- Will ensure compliance with all GMP's (Good Manufacturing Practice) and Safety Standards.
- Perform equipment change-overs and production line set ups.

Job Requirements:

- Journeyman Millwright or Electrician Certification, dual ticketed is an asset.
- 0-5 years of industrial maintenance experience required.
- Bottling and can line maintenance experience in the food/packaging goods industry is an asset.
- Prior diagnostic/troubleshooting and preventative maintenance experience preferred.
- Programmable Logic Control (PLC) knowledge is an asset and highly recommended
- The ability to work rotating shifts to cover the plants operational needs, including overtime
- Ability to obtain a 4th class boiler ticket is mandatory
- Strong trouble shooting skills and the ability to work efficiently under time restraints
- Basic computer skills.
- Ability to follow manufacturer's specifications and schematics.

- Must have own hand tools.
