The assessment of your work experience in the Heavy Equipment Technician trade is completed and we have determined you are eligible for the Trades Qualifier Program. This allows you to work in this trade in Alberta under the supervision of a qualified tradesperson while you challenge the required exams for your certification. However, you must also have a valid work permit issued by the Government of Canada.

This letter is **valid until August 27, 2020** and you must arrive in Alberta Canada **by this date**. Upon arrival in Alberta, you have **one year from the date you enter Canada** to complete the Trades Qualifier Program requirements.

Once you have arrived in Alberta you **must** complete the attached **Arrival Form** and submit it within 7 working days to the address indicated on the form. If we do not receive an arrival form from you before this letter expires, your application will be cancelled. If you are applying from within Alberta you are also required to submit the arrival form prior to starting work with an Alberta employer.
