Crew Boss (S-230) /Engine Boss (S-231)

Class Description:

Crew Boss: Training for the single resource boss position from initial dispatch through demobilization to the home unit. Topics include operational leadership, preparation and mobilization, assignment preparation, risk management, entrapment avoidance, safety and tactics, offline duties, demobilization, and post incident responsibilities.

Engine Boss: Designed to produce student proficiency in the performance of the duties associated with ENGB. Topics include engine and crew capabilities and limitations, information sources, fire size-up considerations, tactics, and wildland/urban interface.

Pat Shreffler has 45 years of fire experience that includes Kern County Fire Department Training Officer and USFS Battalion Chief. Pat served 22 years on Type I and II Incident Management Teams.
