Designed to meet the training needs of the Safety Officer position in the incident command system and the requirements of CICCIS Qualifications for Type 3 and Line Safety Officer.

ICS 100: Intro. to ICS, ICS 200: Single Resource and Initial Action Incidents, ICS 300: Intermediate ICS, IS-0700.a, National Incident Management System, An Introduction; and IS-0800.b, National Response Framework
