WRITTEN EXAM:

Initial:

⇒ You must achieve a minimum **cumulative** score of 70% on a total of two written exams. (See class schedule for exam dates/times)

PERFORMANCE BASED TESTING:

Initial:

- ⇒ You will participate in (2) Final Practical Scenarios which will be evaluated by an instructor. Failure to successfully complete practical scenarios will result in failure of the course.
- ⇒ You must achieve a 70% minimum score on each scenario.

STUDENT ATTENDANCE:

Initial:

- ⇒ You are expected to be **on time** to all classroom and practical exercises.
- ⇒ Missing more than five percent (5%) of the course will result in a failure of POST and Academy standards (six hours)
 - ✓ Classes are mandatory. (*If you need to miss time from the Academy, or need to leave at any time, check with your Coordinator first*).
 - ✓ Absence slips must be turned in to the Coordinator immediately following the absence.
 - ✓ Students are responsible for any instruction missed due to absence.

STUDENT CONDUCT:

- ⇒ Students are expected to maintain the highest professional standards of conduct and behavior.
- ⇒ Students will be held to the Academy's Standards of professionalism and conduct as outlined in the Student Procedures Manual.
