Academy PERFORMANCE Standard:

Initial:

- Recruits must achieve an overall academic/performance average of 80% to successfully complete the course.

RECRUIT CONDUCT

Initial:

- Recruits are expected to maintain the highest professional standards of conduct and behavior.
- Recruits will be held to the Academy's Standards of Professionalism and Conduct as outlined in the Recruit Procedures Manual.
- Recruits are expected to report misconduct immediately to the Academy Coordinator.
- Recruits may be disciplined up to and including termination from the program for failure to follow Academy Policy and Procedure.

RECRUIT ATTENDANCE:

Initial:

- Mandatory pass requirement
- Affects overall performance percentage and requirement of 80%.
- 164 Hour Course
- Missing five percent (5%) of the course (8.2 hours) will result in a failure of POST and Academy standards attendance.
- Recruits missing more than four (4) hours will be issued an Academy Notice of Deficiency.
- Classes are mandatory; missing time from the Academy must be pre-approved by the Academy Coordinator. All absences must be reported to the Academy Coordinator.
- Absence slips must be completed and submitted to the Coordinator at the start of the next training day attended.
- There will be no make-up or rescheduled classes due to unexcused absences.

UNIFORM INSPECTIONS:**Initial:**

- Affects overall performance percentage and requirement of 80%.
- Daily informal inspections
- Formal inspections are identified on the schedule
- 4 graded regular inspections (inspections may be combined per Training Officer)
- Must be able to demonstrate team marching and recite the first two paragraphs of the Law Enforcement Code of Ethics by the last inspection

HOMEWORK:**Initial:**

- Affects overall academic/performance average of 80%.
- Grading standards are outlined in the homework section of the Recruit Manual.
 - Assignments are graded by Academy Staff.
 - Assignments are worth 50 points (unless otherwise specified).
 - Refer to course schedule for homework assignment and due dates.
 - Assignments must meet standards outlined by the Academy Coordinator.

PERFORMANCE EVALUATIONS:**Initial:**

- Affects overall performance percentage of 80%.
- Recruits will receive (1) one evaluation.
- Guidelines are outlined in the Recruit Manual.

POST WRITTEN TESTS:**Initial:**

- 20 POST Learning Domains (LD's)
- 5 Written LD tests:
 - LD's: 2, 5, 31, 34, 36
- Final Exam: (2hrs) Covers the following LD's from BAM Level III:
 - 2, 3, 5, 15, 16, 20, 31, 36 and 39
- Must achieve POST Cut Score
- LD Academic Failure Rule:
- Failure of (4) four LD Exams will result in academic dismissal from the course
- Failure of (3) Three L.D. Exams will result in an Academy Notice of Deficiency
- Failure of any POST Re-test is an academic failure of the course
- Remedial instruction and testing will be administered per Academy Guidelines

ACADEMY TESTS:**Initial:**

- Affects overall academic/performance average of 80%.
- 80% minimum cut score (unless otherwise specified)
 - Does not count toward LD Academic Failure Rule
- Academy tests may include, but are not limited to:
 - Recruit Procedures Manual Exam
 - Range Safety Test-100% required score
 - *Students may not carry firearms until successfully passing the range safety test.*
 - Radio Code Quizzes

FIREARMS TRAINING:**Initial:**

- Mandatory pass Component
- Five (5) Range shooting sessions
- Affects overall 80% academic/performance average
- Required Skills Tests include:
 - PC 832 Qualification Course
- Failure of the Re-tests will result in a failure of the course
- Remedial training and re-testing will be scheduled by Academy Coordinator

DEFENSIVE TACTICS:**Initial:**

- Mandatory Pass Component.
- Affects overall academic/performance average of 80%.
- Required skills tests include:
 - Final Exam
- Failure of a Re-test will result in academic dismissal from the course.

DEFENSIVE DRIVING:**Initial:**

- Mandatory pass Component
- Required Exercise Test set by POST
 - Slow Speed
 - Refer to POST Training and Testing Specifications document
- Failure of the Re-test is a failure of the course
- Affects overall 80% average

REPORT WRITING:**Initial:**

- Affects overall (80%) academic/performance percentage
- 1 graded report

REMEDIAL EXAM POLICY:**Initial:**

- Remedial training will be offered for recruits who fail a required test.
- Remedial instruction will be administered in accordance with Academy guidelines and recruits are expected to adhere to such guidelines (attend scheduled training, sign documents, etc).
- It is the recruit's responsibility to attend remedial sessions offered.
- Unless otherwise directed by the Academy Coordinator, there will be no make-up sessions provided.
- Recruits who fail to attend a pre-arranged remedial session will forfeit the training offered.
- The Academy staff will administer the Re-test after approximately 48-hours from the time of remedial instruction. This procedure provides the recruit time to study and prepare for the pending remedial exam.
- Failure of a Re-test will result in academic dismissal of the course.
