Designed by INC Architecture & Design, the Lamé series of nesting, occasional and dining tables characterized by their expressive shapes, a singular material gesture and structural daring are both simple and sensuous.

Named after the mathematician who pioneered curvilinear arithmetics, Gabriel Lamé, the Lamé table series is at once precise and gestural.

Like an ingenious puzzle, each uniquely shaped slab has been carefully sculpted to key into its partners without fasteners to create a balanced whole.





Developed as functional sculpture, the organic silhouettes of these deceptively simple tables have been rendered with an abstract clarity that is meant to balance natural and nurtured form.

The freedom of shape made possible through computer aided stone cutting, combined with traditional stone carving techniques, lend these artfully realized objects a timely and timeless character.

Like sand or earth rendered solid, the subtle shifting movement of the stones selected for these tables in their initial offering work as a foil to the flowing curvaceous lines.

KEY FEATURES:

Flat pack

The flatpack feature allows for easy assembly of the tables. Each uniquely shaped slab has been carefully sculpted to key into its partners without fasteners to create a balanced whole.

Natural Material

The primary materials emphasize the raw beauty found in nature. The stones have a unique fossil-like quality, and a neutral color palette.

Organic Form.

Developed as functional sculpture, the organic silhouettes of these deceptively simple tables have been rendered with an abstract clarity that is meant to balance natural and nurtured form. Table 1 - **Low nesting table**

length (37 1/2'') x width (39'') x height (12'')

The low nesting table is an irregular trapezoid-shaped coffee table ideal for living room spaces. The varied angles of the table are suitable for seating arrangements with either linear or curved sofas. Out of the nesting tables, this coffee table has the lowest height.



Parts of the table base pierce beyond the table's surface, adding to its irregular shape.

Table 2 - **Medium nesting table**

length (43 3/8'') x width (22'') x height (15'')

The medium nesting table is an irregular rectangular shaped coffee table suitable for linear seating groupings. The corners of the table are rounded, adding to the soft, organic qualities of the design. Parts of the table base pierce beyond and under the surface of the table.



Table 3 - **High nesting table**

length (34 3/4'') x width (27 1/8'') x height (18'')

The high nesting table is the highest of the three main nesting tables and perfect for tight seating groups. Its irregular shape and inverse cut of the base leg allows for more flexibility with nesting the coffee tables.



Parts of the table base pierce beyond the table's surface, adding to its irregular shape.

Table 4 - **Occasional table**

length (21'') x width (20 1/4'') x height (21'')

The occasional table is a side table that can stand alone as an end table or form a cluster with the three coffee tables. This organic, irregular-shaped table consists of three unique flatpack parts that key into each other.



A key feature of this table is the dramatic curve of part of the base.

Table 5 - **Rectangular dining table/desk**

length (101 1/2'') x width (40'') x height (29'')

Suitable for the dining room or a home office, this rectangular table consists of five flatpack pieces that key together.

The base connects and forms a cross shape at the surface of the irregular rectangular table top.

Comfortably seats up to 6 to 8 people.



Table 6 - **Round dining table**

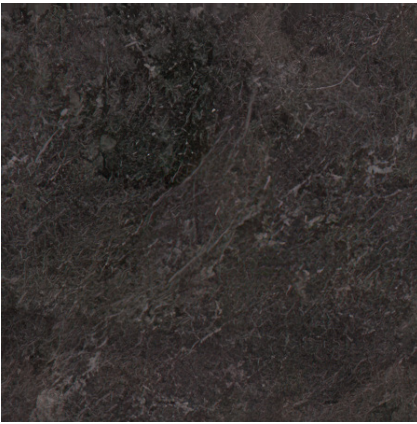
length (58 5/8'') x width (58 1/2'') x height (29'')

The round dining table is irregular and unique in its shape. It consists of three flatpack pieces that key together and a base that connects and forms a cross shape at the surface of the irregular hexagon table top.

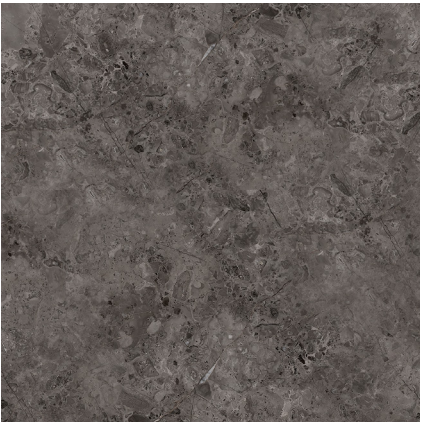


It seats up to 8 comfortably. The two parts of the base key together to support the table top. The keyed base fits into the cross cut out, giving the table utmost stability.

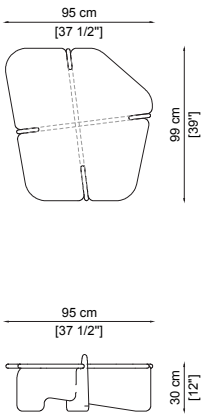


Table 2 - Medium nesting table

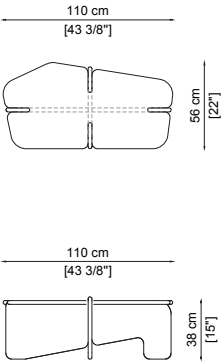


Table 3 - High nesting table

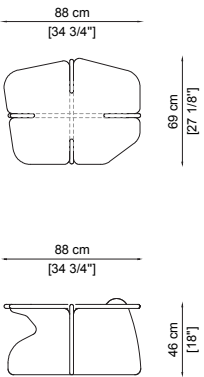


Table 4 - Occasional table

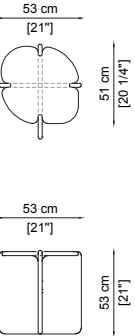


Table 5 - Rectangular dining table/desk

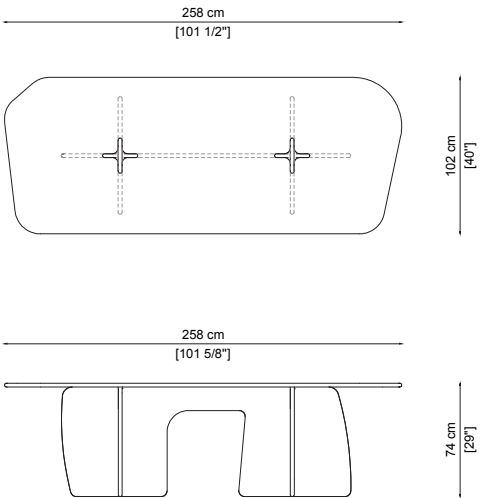
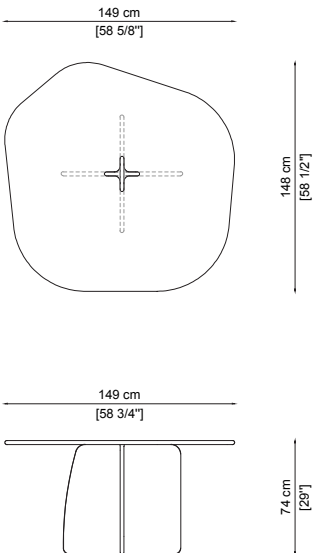


Table 6 - Round dining table
